Patrol Rifle Concepts (AJS140AA)

A basic class on the operation and deployment of the carbine in law enforcement operations. Includes basic operation concepts as well as deployment methods and purposes.

Class is 16 hours in length and is AzPOST approved for 16 hours of continuing or proficiency training for law enforcement officers.

Class format: Two contiguous days at the range. Day one is 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and day two is 12 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Costs: 1 credit hour plus \$35 course fee. There is also a \$15 registration fee if you are not currently enrolled at GCC.

Student Requirements: Students must provide a suitable shoulder AR-15 or AR-10 rifle platform. (.223 or 5.56 mm, 7.62mm x 39mm caliber.) A minimum of 700 rounds of ammunition for the rifle. Sidearm with holster and 50 rounds for that weapon. Standard safety equipment (eye and ear protection and a brimmed cap), knee and elbow protection (optional). A flashlight will be required for the second day of class.

Class Location: Maricopa County Sheriff's Office Range, 26900 W. Buckeye Hills Drive, Buckeye. Directions: West on I-10, Exit 112, head south on US 85 towards Gila Bend. Look for MP144 and turn right on Buckeye Hills Drive. You should see a large tractor-trailer with an MCSO hiring banner. Continue past the Joe Foss range for approximately 1 mile to the MCSO range.
